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Activities

We will implement three sets of activities.

The first one is aimed at **collecting and interpreting data on Ukrainian students at partner universities** (in order to identify their basic socio-economic background). This is followed by **primary data collection in the form of unified surveys** addressed to Ukrainian students, domestic students and domestic teachers. The last set of activities involves the **share of knowledge on a scientific and expert platform** (domestic, international conferences).
